## KEEPING SAFE

Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum  
The Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum is a child safety program for children and young people from ages 3 – Year 12. The program is mandated in all public preschools and schools and is taught every year.

The program explores four focus areas: The right to be safe, Relationships, Recognising and reporting abuse and Protective strategies. The focus areas are targeted to the age of the learners with the curriculum broken down into Early Years: Ages 3 – 5; Early Years: Years R – 2; Primary Years: Years 3 – 5; Middle Years: Years 6 – 9 and Senior Years: Year 10 – 12.
